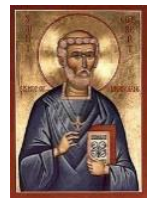

THE BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST: In St Mark's telling of the Last Supper, Jesus offers his disciples the cup and says, "This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many". The literal sense of these words is clear. The Eucharist is necessary for our salvation. Christ's one sacrifice on the Cross is present each Mass in the Precious Body & Blood. The sacrifice, in which we share, binds us in the joyful freedom of God's New Covenant. We become Children of God. As Catholics we believe in the Real Presence. Through the sacrament we become heirs to the Kingdom. Rejoice, we are joyful Children of God (*Deacon Ed Souza*).

THE SACRED HEART - EXPOSITION: The first Friday of the month in June falls on the solemnity of The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Devotion to the Sacred Heart, encouraged by mediaeval mystics and promoted by St Gertrude, St Margaret and others, represents a devotion to Jesus in his human nature, in particular referring to the heart as the seat of the emotions. There will be **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament** at St Luke's before the morning Mass from 8:30am. Please join us if you are able.
