THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY will be celebrated on Monday, 9th December with an extra evening Mass at 6:30pm at St Luke's. This day is also the anniversary of the consecration of St Luke's Church by Bishop Joseph Gray in 1981. Please do join us if you are able.

JUBILEE YEAR: A Jubilee or Holy Year, celebrated every 25 years, is a special year of forgiveness and reconciliation, in which people are invited to come back into right relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation. The theme for the Jubilee Year 2025 is *Pilgrims of Hope* and it will be a year of hope for a world suffering the impacts of war, the ongoing effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the climate crisis. The Papal Bull for the Jubilee Year (*Hope does not disappoint*) urges us to **look for signs of hope in the world around us** and work for peace and justice. The beginning of the Jubilee Year will be marked by the opening of the Holy Door of St Peter's Basilica in the Vatican on Christmas Eve, and will conclude on 6 January 2026. A companion booklet for the year will be available shortly.
