**NEW LECTIONARY:** As was mentioned in last week's newsletter, the new Lectionary will begin at the start of Advent 2024. We need to purchase new Ambo editions (large size for use by priest and readers during services) for use **at both our parish churches**. This will prove to be quite costly as the 4-volume basic set needed at each church costs **almost £700**, with other volumes also being necessary. The Diocese has suggested to all churches that parishioners might wish to "sponsor" one of the volumes.

Each volume comes with a presentation sticker for sponsors names to be included inside the liturgical books, should you wish. **VISIT OF RELIC OF BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS:** The Relic of Blessed Carlo Acutis will be visiting the Diocese at St Anthony's, Wythenshawe, between 20 and 23 September 2024. This remarkable teenager was a gamer and computer programmer who loved football, with a gift for empathy, a great devotion to Our



Lady and a deep love of the Holy Eucharist which he described as his 'highway to heaven'. The visit to the Diocese is a very special opportunity to spend time in prayer venerating the Relic of Blessed Carlo Acutis. Confessions will be available, and Mass will be celebrated on each of the days. There will also be inspirational talks on Saturday and Sunday from Monsignor Anthony Figueirdo, STD, who has followed the life of the soon to be Saint Carlo Acutis.
