ONGOING REFURBISHMENTS: The very challenging work on the new roof, which has gone well past the projected date of completion, has delayed other internal developments. Obviously, addressing the roof leaks has been of primary importance (with the window in the tower still to be fixed to prevent leaks). Following a visit from Canon Chris Matthews, at a recent meeting of the Diocesan Heritage, Art & Architecture Committee, it was agreed that the Tabernacle at St Luke's Church could be relocated to the centre of the main sanctuary, against the back wall, using the existing tabernacle plinth.

POSADA JOURNEY: Our Posada, from the Spanish meaning "hospitality", allows us to recreate the journey that Joseph and Mary made on their way to Bethlehem, where Jesus was born. A statue of Our Lady travels round families who "host" her for the night until she returns to Church on Christmas Eve for the Festival of the Nativity. Mary will begin her journey on the First Sunday of Advent, 1st December, when she will be blessed at the 11am Mass.
