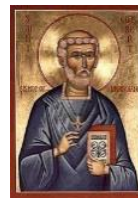

**FOODBANK COLLECTION:** Our monthly foodbank collection at both churches will be next weekend, 27<sup>th</sup>/28<sup>th</sup> July. This month they are particularly in need of the following: instant noodle meals, custard, desserts (jelly, rice pudding), coffee & long-life milk/fruit juice (Mid-Cheshire – St Cuthbert's); long-life milk, baby food (tins or pouches, not baby milk), tinned spaghetti, tinned meat, tinned tomatoes & long grain rice (Runcorn & District – St Luke's).
